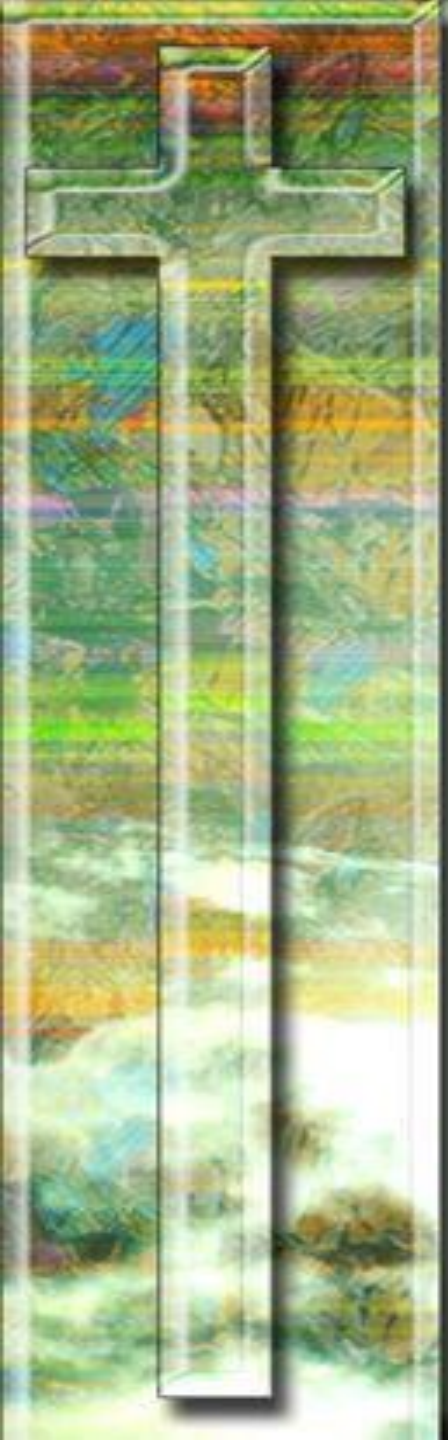

2) Romans 12:3, You already possess the seed of faith.

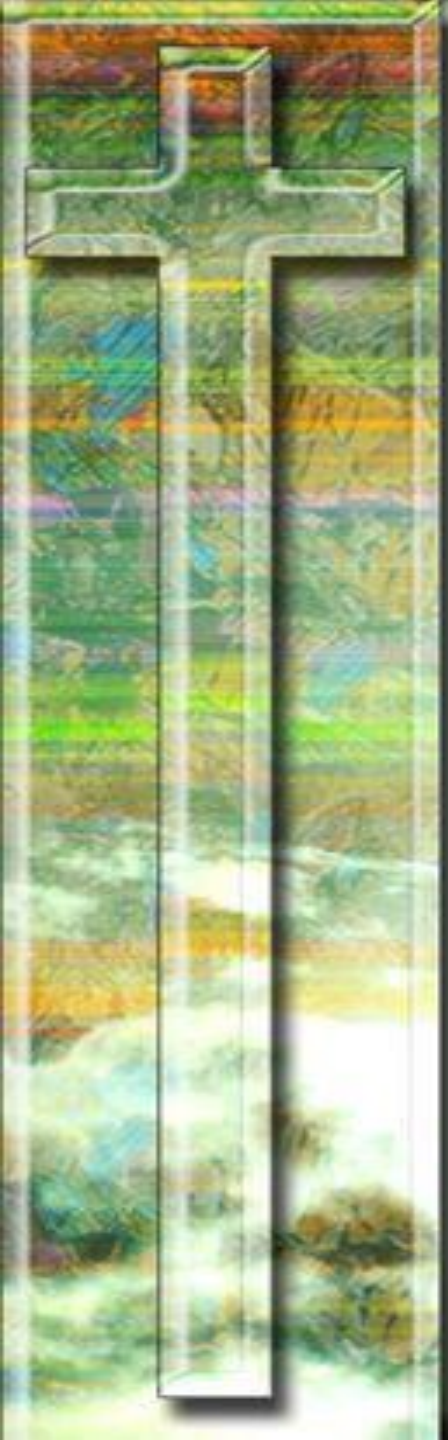

35 I went after him and fought him and saved it from his mouth. When he came against me, I took hold of him by the hair of his head and hit him and killed him.

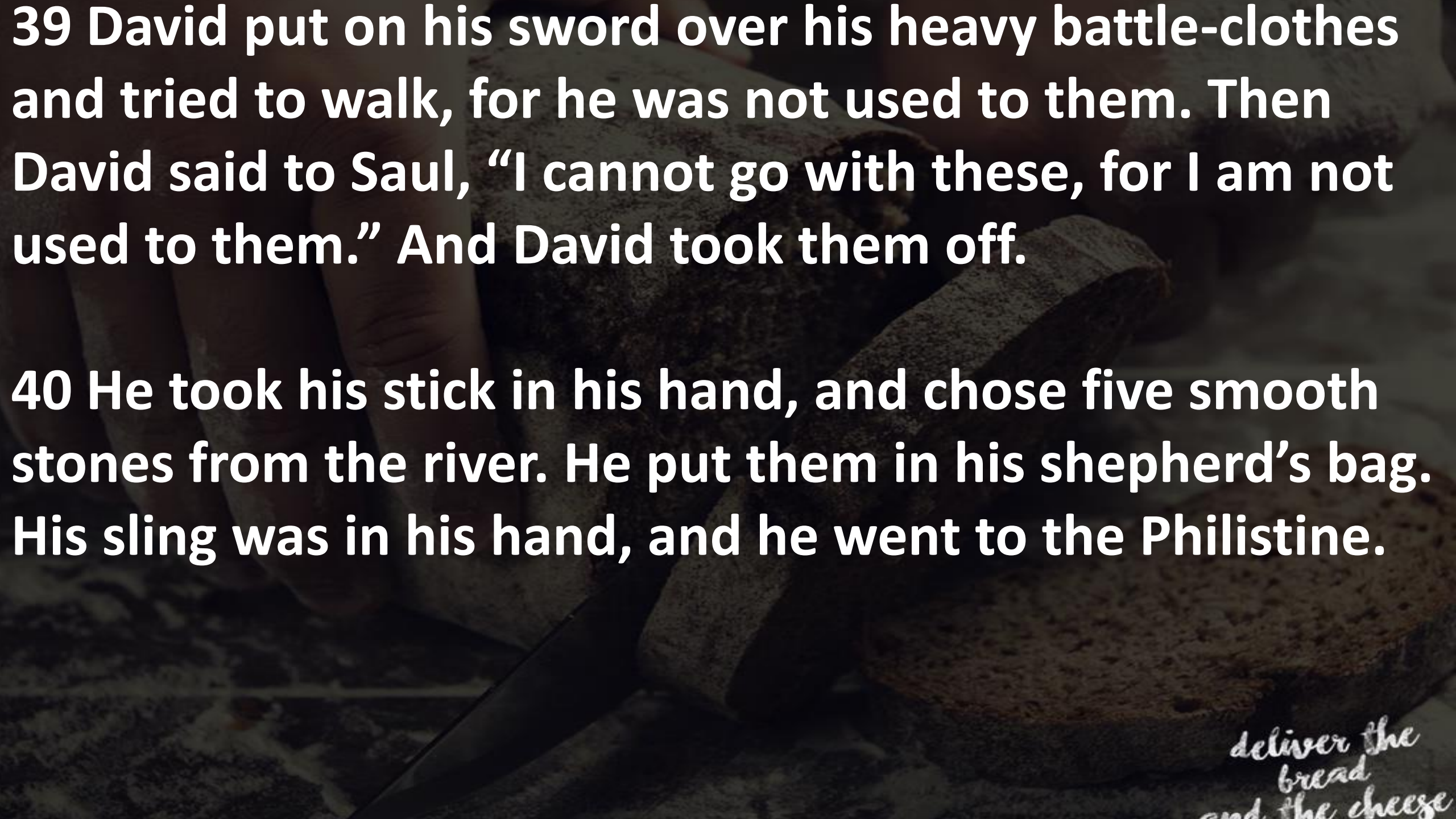
36 Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear. And this Philistine who has not gone through our religious act will be like one of them. For he has made fun of the armies of the living God.

38 Then Saul dressed David with his clothes. He put a brass head covering on his head, and dressed him with heavy battle-clothes.

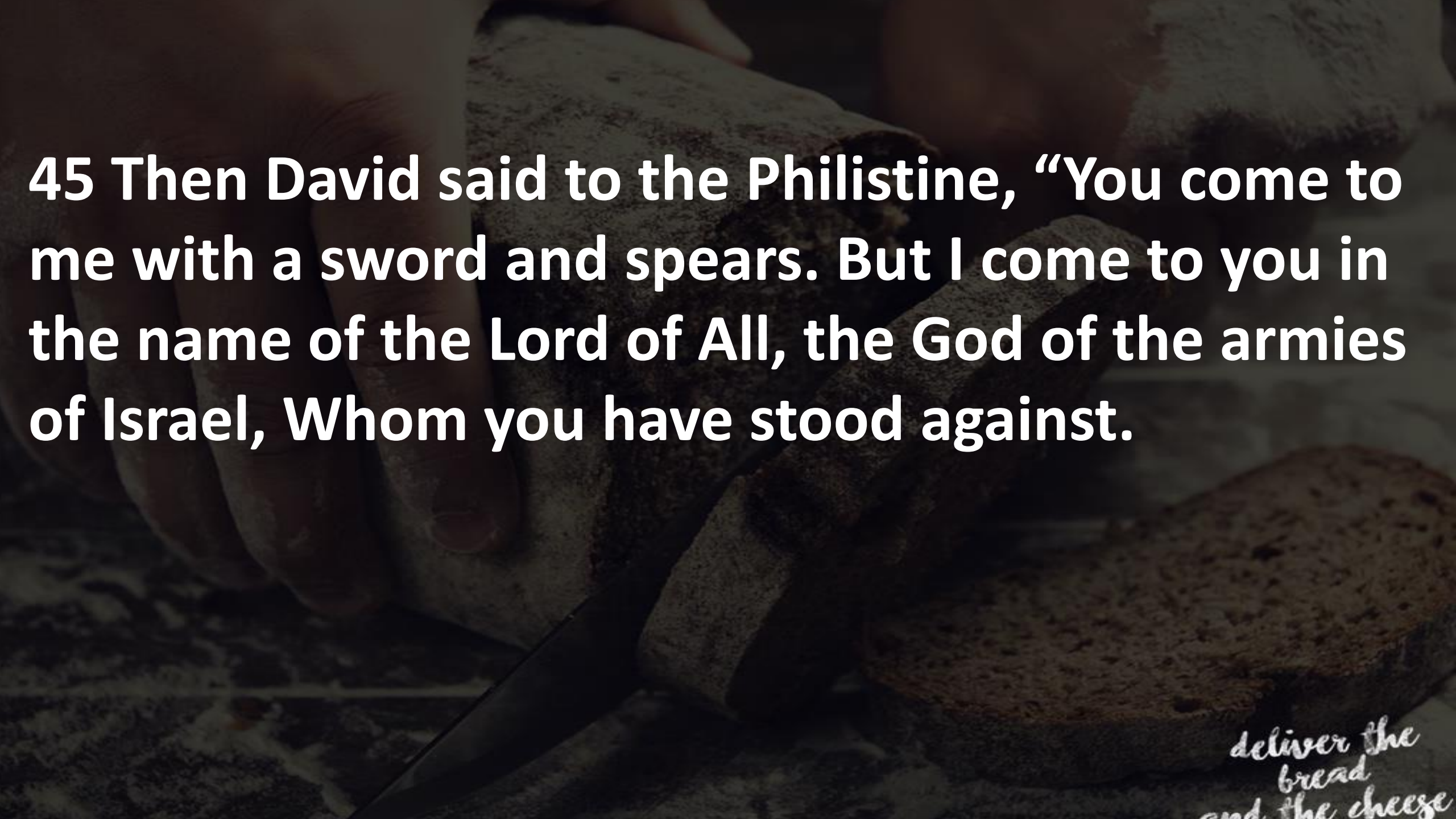

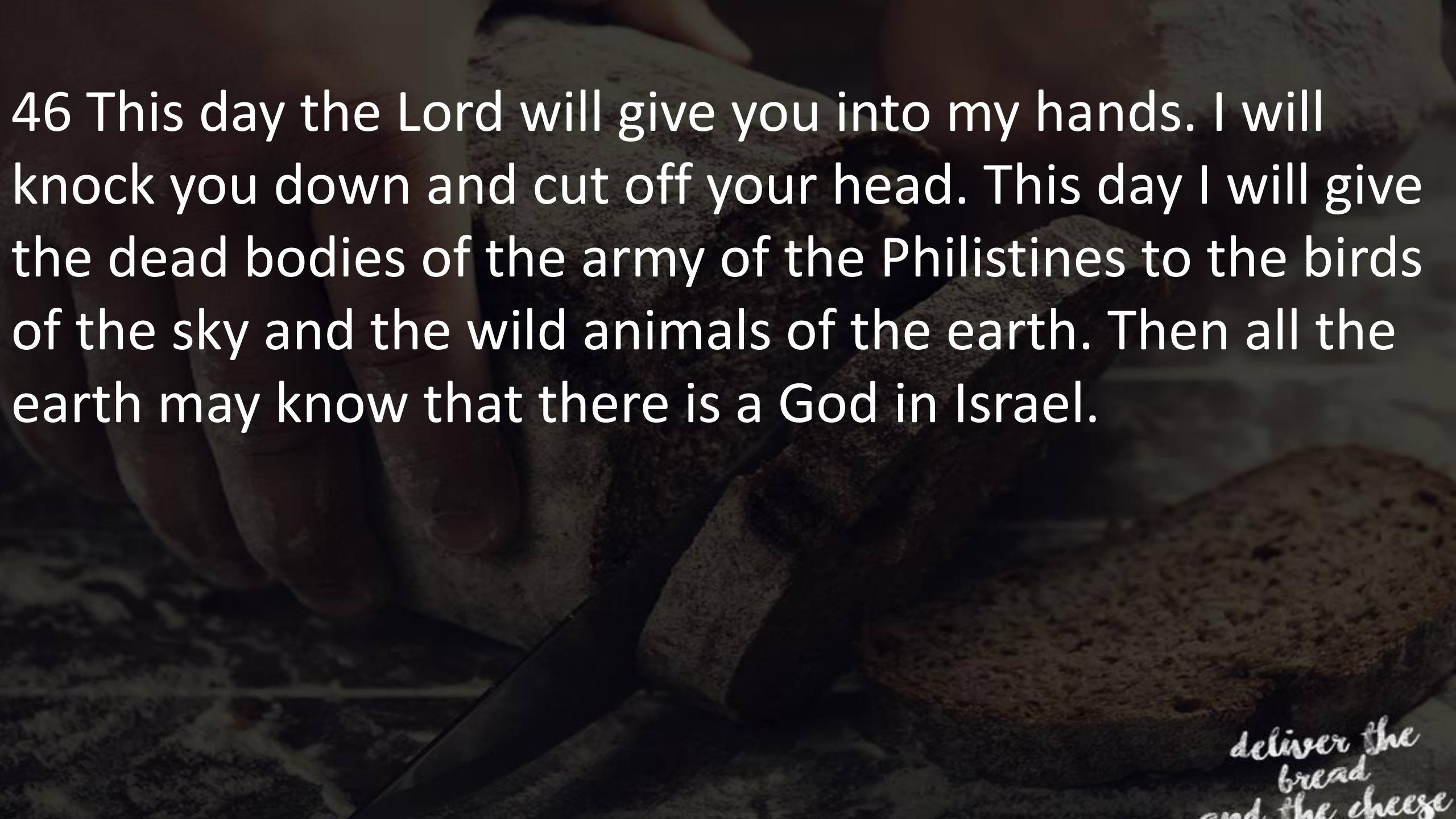
40 He took his stick in his hand, and chose five smooth stones from the river. He put them in his shepherd’s bag. His sling was in his hand, and he went to the Philistine.

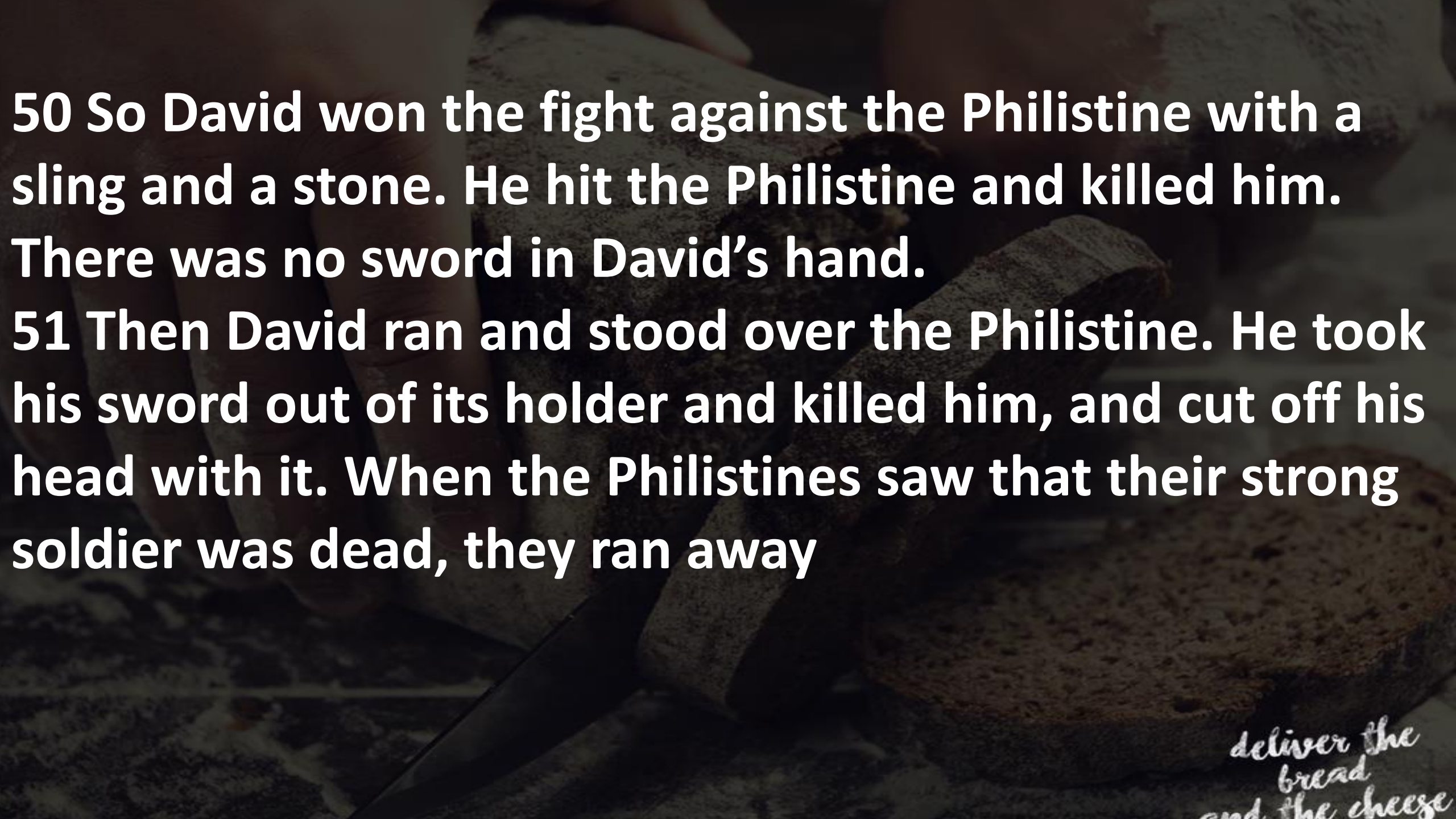

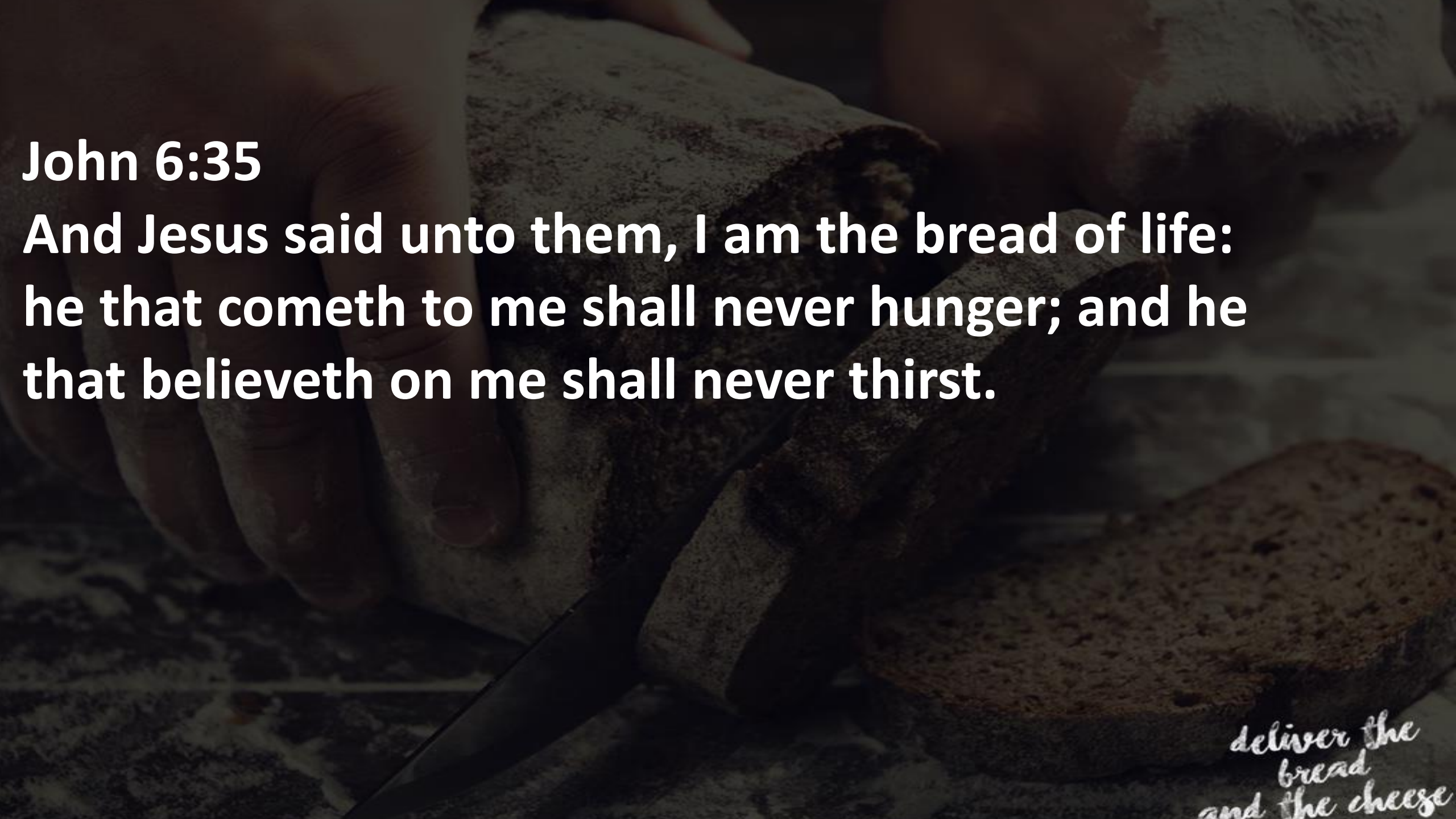
