- Foundation scripture: (Mark 12:41-44 GWT)

“As Jesus sat facing the temple offering box, he watched how [much] money people put into it. Many rich people put in large amounts. A poor widow dropped in two small coins, worth less than a cent. He called his disciples and said to them, “I can guarantee this truth: This poor widow has given more than all the others. All of them have given what they could spare. But she, in her poverty, has given everything she had to live on.”

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- God will always recognize the giver who sows from the heart. (Jeremiah 17:10 GWT)
- There will never be a day in your life when you have nothing to sow. (2 Corinthians 9:10 GWT)

- Foundation scripture: (Mark 12:41-44 GWT)
- When you ask God for a harvest, God will always ask you for a seed. (Luke 6:38 GWT)
- When you increase the size of your seed, you increase the size of your harvest. (2 Corinthians 9:6-7 GWT)
- When God talks to you about a seed, He's already got a harvest on His mind. (Proverbs 3:9-11 GWT)
