



Conflict in the Family, What Do I Do? – 6/3/18

▪ Foundation scripture: (Joshua 24:14-16 GWT)

“Fear the LORD, and serve him with integrity and faithfulness. Get rid of the gods your ancestors served on the other side of the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve only the LORD. But if you don’t want to serve the LORD, then choose today whom you will serve. Even if you choose the gods your ancestors served on the other side of the Euphrates or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you live, my family and I will still serve the LORD.” The people responded, “It would be unthinkable for us to abandon the LORD to serve other gods.”

- Acknowledge conflict (if your brother sins against you). (Matthew 18:15 NIV)
- I must own responsibility (you). (Matthew 5:23-24 NIV)
- Approach the people we are in conflict with (go). (Ephesians 4:26 NIV)
- No third parties (directly to the person). (Matthew 18:16 NIV)
- Use sensitivity (just between the two of you). (Luke 6:31 NIV)
- Direct communication (if he listens to you). Aim at reconciliation (win your brother over).
