Forgiveness, What A “Word” – 9/9/18

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- Forgiveness is a command, not a suggestion. (Matthew 6:14-15 NIV)
- There is no limit to forgiveness. (Matthew 18:21-22 NIV)
- Unforgiveness holds us in bondage. (2 Corinthians 2:10-11 NLT)
- Forgiveness is a voluntary act. (Luke 17:2-4 NLT)
- Reconciliation is what we should try to do. (Romans 12:16-18 NIV)



Put The Poison Down – 9/16/18

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- Forgiveness will hold you and others in bondage. (Psalm 32:1-3 GWT)
- Unforgiveness will stop you from moving your mountain. (Mark 11:22-26 GWT)
- Forgiveness and fellowship with God activates your blessings. (Luke 31:36 GWT)



Forgiveness and Reconciliation are Connected But Not the Same – 9/23/18

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- Forgiveness plus full reconciliation is not always right. (Matthew 18:15-17 GWT)
- Forgiveness is commanded, reconciliation is not always possible. (Ezekiel 3:17-19 GWT)
